

HMRC - CASC Payment

One of the advantages of being registered as a **Community Amateur Sports Club** (CASC) is that, like registered Charities, we can claim back the tax portion of any donations made to us by UK Tax Payers.

In the 2018-19 Club year this amounted to £303.48 extra income for the Club. Of this £228.65 was attributable to the Mini-Fest, taking the 2019 event profit up to £1,405.32!

Another advantage of being a **CASC** is that we receive a substantial discount the Club has to pay in Council Tax for the clubroom. Last year it only cost us £9.91!
